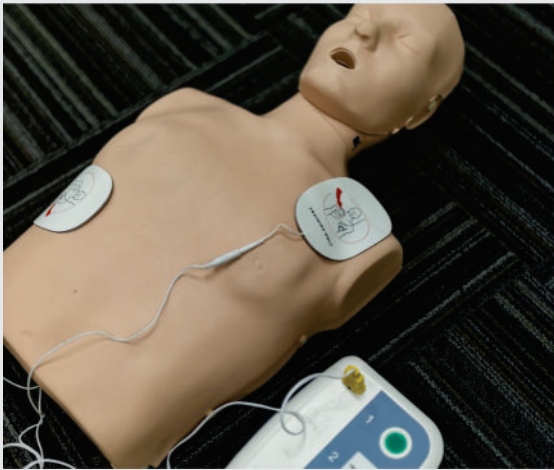

The Safe Work Australia First Aid in the Workplace Model Code of Practice requires employers to ensure that their nominated first aiders attend training on a regular basis to ensure currency.

The Code of Practice recommends that refresher training in CPR should be completed annually (12 months) and first aid qualifications should be renewed every three (3) years.
