## Pre-requisite

Students must hold:

- a CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care

OR

- a CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care

Alternatively, individuals may hold:

- An Australian diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care

OR

- An Australian diploma or certificate III in Children's Services.

AND

- Demonstrate at least 12 months of cumulative employment (full-time equivalent) within the last 5 years in a regulated education and care service in Australia, supported by verifiable evidence.

OR

- Hold the CHCSS00147 Entry into Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care.

## Entry Requirements

- Be an Australian citizen, permanent resident or eligible visa holder
- Have suitable Language, Literacy and Numeracy Skills to complete a Diploma
- Have a valid Unique Student Identifier (USI) to study any qualification or short course in Australia. To create a USI please visit [www.usi.gov.au](http://www.usi.gov.au)
- Willingness to commit to study.
