Students of participating institutions must apply for their Tertiary SmartRider via the institutions appointed authorised SmartRider Retail Outlet, no forms are required.

A \$5.00 card fee and minimum add value amount of \$5.00 applies.

How to apply

1. Complete every section on the application form and sign the Student Declaration.
2. The application must be stamped by an Authorised Officer of the institution to certify the students full-time standing and expected course completion date.
3. This form must be submitted to any Transperth InfoCentre or authorised SmartRider Retail Sales Outlet. A \$5.00 card fee and minimum add value amount of \$5.00 applies.

Expiry of Tertiary SmartRider: Non-participating institutions only

The concession expiry date of Tertiary SmartRider issued to students attending non-participating institutions will be a maximum of 31 March in the year following application, or a lesser period as detailed by the institution. Your Tertiary SmartRider concession entitlement is set to expire annually on this date, and accordingly students must submit a new form.

If you do not renew your Tertiary SmartRider entitlement before the expiry date, your Tertiary SmartRider will revert to standard fares until your concession entitlement is renewed.

Identification

Passengers travelling with a Tertiary SmartRider are asked to note that they may be required to provide additional identification to confirm their identity. Students must have a valid Tertiary SmartRider in their possession to receive a concession entitlement and no other form of concession will be accepted.

When purchasing a concession cash ticket from ticketing vending machines or bus/ferry drivers, a Tertiary SmartRider is the only valid ID that proves they are a full-time student. Student cards or any other form of ID are not accepted as proof of concession when travelling on Transperth services.

Conditions of application

1. I understand that as a full-time student attending a tertiary institution, I am entitled to discounted concession fares on Transperth services subject to satisfying the conditions detailed on this application form and being issued with a Tertiary SmartRider concession.
2. I understand that a Tertiary SmartRider concession is issued subject to the conditions of the Public Transport Authority Act and Public Transport Authority Regulations 2003.
3. I understand that any false or misleading statements made on this application form may result in my being prosecuted under the Public Transport Authority Act 2003 and Public Transport Authority Regulations 2003.
4. I understand that a Tertiary SmartRider concession may only be used by the student to whom it is issued and that penalties may apply for improper use.
5. I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that I continue to meet the ongoing eligibility requirements for the Tertiary SmartRider concession and to advise the Public Transport Authority immediately in writing should this be no longer the case.
6. I consent to the collection, use and disclosure of my information in accordance with Public Transport Authority's Privacy Statement available at transperth.wa.gov.au
7. I understand that to obtain my Tertiary SmartRider concession, I must submit this application form.
8. SmartRiders are not transferable or refundable.
9. A person may only have one valid Concession SmartRider registered in their name at any one time. When more than one concession card is registered in a person's name, the most recent registered card will remain as a concession card, with all previous concession cards reverting to a standard SmartRider.
10. I understand that if a Concession SmartRider reverts to a standard I may be required to complete a new form.
